

Rock The Promo Video Contest OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR ODDS OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED. VALID IN THE 48 CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA ONLY. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES.

1. SPONSOR:

The Rock the Promo Video Contest (the "Contest") is sponsored by Studio71, located at 8383 Wilshire Boulevard, Suite 1050, Beverly Hills, CA 90211 ("Sponsor"). YouTube is not a sponsor of the Contest.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

Contest is open only to legal residents of the continental United States including the District of Columbia, age 18 or older at time of entry. Contest is void in Puerto Rico, U.S. territories and possessions, outside of the U.S., and where prohibited by law.

Employees, interns, contractors, and official office-holders of Sponsor, Seven Bucks Productions, and their respective parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, and their respective directors, officers, employees, advertising and promotion agencies, representatives, and agents ("Contest Entities"), and members of the Contest Entities' and their immediate families (parents, siblings, children, spouses, and life partners of each, regardless of where they live) and members of the households (whether related or not) of such employees, officers and directors are ineligible to participate in this Contest.

SPONSOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESTRICT PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST OR DISQUALIFY ANY ENTRY IN THE CONTEST FOR ANY REASON INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY ACT IN VIOLATION OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES OR ANY DISRUPTIVE, UNETHICAL, OR ILLEGAL CONDUCT.

3. CONTEST PERIOD:

The Contest begins at 12:00:00 AM Pacific Standard Time ("PST") on **July 6th, 2016** and ends at 11:59:59 PM PST on September 30, 2016 ("Contest Period").

4. HOW TO ENTER:

After Dwayne "the Rock" Johnson's call to action, to enter the Contest and be selected as one of the thirty-two (32) Contest's contestants, Entrants (each, an "Entrant") must visit the Contest website, www.rockthepromo.studio71us.com (the "Website") and follow the instructions. Specifically, Entrants will be required to upload their speech / promo video (the "Entry Video") to YouTube.com, and **unlist** the video. If you have any questions about unlisting your Entry Video on YouTube, <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=fViYcDDZyhk> Entrants will also be

required to submit as part of registration on the Website certain contact information, including but not limited to the Entrant's name, age, address, phone number, email address, social media usernames, and a photo of themselves. Finally, Entrant's must answer certain questions about their background, including whether they've been arrested, and if so, why.

All media and content submitted by Entrant, including Entry Videos, Contest Videos (defined below), and contact information shall be referred to hereafter as "Submission Materials."

The deadline for all initial submissions is 11:59:59 PM PST, July 13th, 2016.

By entering the Contest, Entrants certify that they have read, understood and agreed to the terms of these Official Rules.

5. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Every Entry Video must comply with the following guidelines:

- Must be 45 seconds long.
- Must include the following, in this order:
 - Passionate declaration of your wrestling name.
Example: "The Rock"
 - Intimidating look.
Example: The Rock's Eyebrow Intimidation
 - Explanation of your character.
 - Why you will win the 2016 Rock The Promo Championship Belt.
 - Catch phrase.
Example: "Can you smell what the rock is cooking?"

More information on what the Entry Video should entail is available on the Contest's website.

Each Entrant entering the Contest hereby warrants and represents that his/her Submission Materials (and each component thereof):

- Is original to him/her and that the Entrant has (or has obtained) all necessary rights (including, without limitation, consent of the videographer) in and to the Submission Materials (and all components thereof, including any rights of publicity) for the purposes of entering the Submission Materials in the Contest and Sponsor's subsequent display and use of the Submission Materials worldwide, in perpetuity, for any and all purposes, in any and all media, now known and hereafter devised.
- Is not unlawful, threatening, abusive, harassing, defamatory, libelous, deceptive,

fraudulent, invasive of another's privacy, tortious, or contain explicit or graphic descriptions or accounts of sexual acts, or otherwise contain any other content that Sponsors deem to be inappropriate.

- Does not victimize, harass, degrade, or intimidate an individual or group of individuals on the basis of religion, gender, sexual orientation, race, ethnicity, age, or disability.
- Does not feature any physical stunts or violence. Any content that appears to place anyone in a dangerous or unsafe situation will result in disqualification.
- Does not contain music, logos, weapons, or profanity.
- Does not otherwise contain an advertisement, solicitation, or other commercial content.
- Complies with YouTube's [Terms of Service](#) and [Community Guidelines](#).
- Meets all the terms of these Official Rules.

In addition, Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to reject or disqualify any Entry Videos or other Submission Materials that do not meet its standards of originality and quality or fails to comply with these Official Rules. Approval is at Sponsor's sole discretion and decisions of Sponsor are final.

6. **CONTEST FORMAT:**

The Contest will run in conjunction and collaboration with a YouTube reality show (the "Show") on the channel Seven Bucks Digital Studios, which will air for 11 weeks and consist of 11 episodes (each, an "Episode"). The first Episode will air on Friday, July 22, 2016, and will feature a mashup of Entry Videos as well as an announcement of Entrants chosen to participate in the Show. Every subsequent episode will air on every subsequent Friday until the Show ends. 6.1 Contestant Notification: The Show's production team will choose the initial thirty-two (32) Entrants who will serve as contestants on the Show (each, a "Contestant") based on the criteria set forth in Section 7 of these Official Rules. The Contestants will be contacted by e-mail or phone prior to July 13, 2016, and must respond to the notification by telephone or email within three (3) days of Sponsor's issuance of notification. Failure to respond completely and within the designated timeframe may result in disqualification and, an alternate Finalist may be selected from among the remaining Contestants based on the judge's score.

6.2 Initial Entry Videos: The selected Contestants will be slotted into single-elimination brackets, and will be announced during the first Episode. There will be five rounds of single-elimination: First Round, Round of 16, Quarterfinals, Semi-Finals, and Finals. Bracket information will be available on the day the first episode of the Show airs, July 22, 2016 by 11:59:59 PM PST. SUBMISSION MATERIALS FROM ALL ENTRANTS, INCLUDING

ENTRANTS NOT SELECTED AS ONE OF THE 32 CONTESTANTS, MAY STILL BE USED FOR PURPOSES OF THE SHOW.

6.3 **First Four Rounds:** Each round will match Contestants against each other based on the Show's bracket. During the First Round of the Show, Contestant's will be judged based on the initial Entry Video provided as part of entry into the Contest. The Entry Videos will be judged (according to the criteria set forth in Section 7) by different guest judges from the professional wrestling world, to be announced by Sponsor. One Contestant in each head-to-head matchup will be chosen to advance past each round based on the judging criteria. After each round, the remaining Contestants will be required to create a new video submission (each, a "Contest Video") for consideration during the next round of the Contest.

Advancing Contestants will have three (3) days following the airing of the Show in which to create this Contest Video for competing in the next Round. Contestants will be provided the information they need to make the new video by 11:59:59 PM PST the day the episode which features them airs (on a Friday). Each advancing Contestant will then be expected to deliver the Contest Video by 11:59:59 PM PST the following Monday (72 hours later).

If an advancing Contestant drops out, fails to comply with these Official Rules, or is otherwise disqualified, another Contestant who was previously eliminated from the Contest will be chosen by the Show's host as a replacement based on the same judging criteria set forth in Section 7.

All Contest Videos must conform to these Official Rules as well as the criteria set forth on Sponsor's Website, which will be updated as the Show and Contest progresses.

The same process for Contestant elimination and creation of Contest Videos shall take place during the first four rounds of the Show.

6.4 **Final Round:** The two Final Round Contestants ("the Finalists") will be flown from a major airport closest to them to a location to be determined by Sponsor. They will meet a superstar in the wrestling world, who shall serve as the judge for the Final Round. Costs for standard airfare, hotel, food, and transport to and from the hotel to the airport, as well as the filming set, will be provided by Sponsor. The trip will take place from September 20, 2016 to September 28, 2016. The Finalists will compete to take home the "Rock The Promo Championship Belt" worth \$2,000.

7. **JUDGING CRITERIA:**

Each Entry Video and Contest Video will be judged, first by the Sponsor's production team for choosing the Contestants, and then by guest judges for each Show to determine which Contestants advance, and ultimately, the Winner, strictly by the merits of the following:

- Character: whoever creates the most vivid, interesting, and fully formed character.
- Comedy: whoever takes the most humorous approach to describing the character.
- Costume: whoever creates a costume that most emphasizes the character's persona in

an entertaining way.

Decisions of the judges are final and binding. No random chance or other criteria will be involved in judging. The Rock The Promo Championship Belt must be won fairly!

8. PRIZE DESCRIPTION:

All Entrants compete for the following prizes (the “Prizes”):

- 1) The winner (the “Winner”) will receive the Grand Prize during the final Episode, which is the Rock The Promo Championship Belt worth approximately \$2,000; and,
- 2) Each of the Finalists who advance to the Final Round of the Show will win a trip to meet a wrestling superstar in a location to be determined by Sponsor. As part of the Finalists’ Prize, the Final Round trip expenses, including: standard airfare, hotel, per diem costs, and transport to and from the hotel to the airport as well as the filming set, will be covered by Sponsor. The Finalists’ trip will take place from September 20, 2016 to September 28, 2016. Approximate retail value for the trip is \$1,000.

Except as set forth above, Finalists are responsible for transportation to and from their place of residence to the nearest commercial airport. Finalists are also responsible for all other expenses not specified herein, including but not limited to airport taxes, gratuities, travel and medical insurance, and any costs of a personal nature. They are solely responsible for all required medical and travel related necessities and documentation.

Winner of the Prizes cannot assign or transfer the Prizes to any other person or entity. Any expenses not stated herein (including, but not limited to, federal, state and local taxes or any other applicable fees or costs not expressly identified above that are related to participation in the Contest and the acceptance and/or use the Prizes) are the sole responsibility of the applicable recipient. Each Finalist must supply Sponsor with his/her social security number for tax purposes. An IRS Form 1099 will be issued in the name of each Finalist for the actual value of the prize received.

There will be no prize otherwise for being chosen as a Contestant nor for advancing in the Contest, except the given opportunities to win the Prizes. When chosen as a Contestant, Entrants agree to compete for the Prizes and forfeit the right to demand any additional compensation.

9. PRIZE ASSIGNABILITY: Finalists cannot assign or transfer their prizes to any other person or entity. Any expenses not stated herein (including, but not limited to, federal, state and local taxes or any other applicable fees or costs not expressly identified above that are related to participation in the Contest and the acceptance and/or use the Prizes) are the sole responsibility of the applicable recipient.

10. SPONSOR’S LICENSES OF SUBMISSION MATERIALS:

As a condition of participating in the Contest, Entrants and Contestants agree that by entering into this Contest he/she is granting Sponsor, Seven Bucks Productions, and any and all of their

respective subsidiaries and affiliates and affiliated broadcast stations and networks, successors and assignees and licensees, the non-exclusive, worldwide irrevocable right and license, but not the obligation, to exhibit, broadcast, publish, copy, reproduce, adapt, encode, compress, encrypt, incorporate data into, modify, create a derivative work from, edit, dub, superimpose, rebroadcast, transmit, record, publicly perform and distribute and synchronize in timed relation to visual elements, the Submission Materials and/or any portions or excerpts thereof, in any manner, an unlimited number of times, in any and all media, now known or hereafter devised for any purpose, throughout the universe, in perpetuity without any attribution or compensation. The Sponsor may use the Submission Materials to advertise, promote and publicize, the Contest, Sponsor, Sponsor's worldwide programming services and/or Sponsor's websites in any and all media throughout the universe and may authorize others to do so; such advertising, promotion and publicity may include portions and excerpts, in addition to cut-in, synchronized, dubbed and superimposed versions of the Submission Materials. Entrants acknowledge that Sponsor may use the Submission Materials in accordance with the permission granted herein without any payment to the undersigned or any third party.

11. PUBLICITY:

By entering and participating in this Contest, Entrants and Contestants, and any who appears in the Submission Materials consent to the Contest Entities' use of each Entrant's name, image, likeness, photograph, voice, and Submission Materials; and Sponsor's and its agents' editing of the Contestant's Submission Materials for use in the Show, advertising, promotional and all other purposes in any and all media, now or hereafter known, worldwide in perpetuity, without further payment or consideration, notification or permission.

12. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Contest, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Contest, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. If, for reasons beyond the control of Sponsor (including, but not limited to, tampering), the Contest is not capable of being executed as originally planned, Sponsor, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to cancel or modify the Contest, without liability. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive or inappropriate manner and void all associated entries. All interpretations of these Official Rules and decisions by the Sponsor are final.

ANY ATTEMPT BY ANY PERSON TO DELIBERATELY UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST MAY BE A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAW, AND, SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, SPONSOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND OTHER REMEDIES (INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES) FROM ANY SUCH PERSON TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. SPONSOR'S FAILURE TO ENFORCE ANY TERM OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE A WAIVER OF THAT PROVISION.

13. OTHER RELEASE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:

Chosen Contestants may be required to prove eligibility, including, without limitation, proof of age and residence, within three (3) days of being notified as a Contestant. In the event of non-compliance by a Contestant, if he/she is found to be ineligible, or if he/she cannot or does not comply with these Official Rules, such Contestant shall be disqualified and all privileges otherwise due as a Contestant shall be terminated and an alternative Contestant shall be chosen from among all of the remaining Entrants received in Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor is not responsible for any change in Entrant's mailing address, email address and/or phone number. Each Contestant must sign within three (3) days of receipt of such documents from Sponsor: (a) a declaration of eligibility and release of the Released Parties (as defined below), from any and all liability, loss, claims, demands, and causes of action for personal injury and/or damage, theft, loss, or any other harm suffered in connection with this Contest, the use/misuse or acceptance of any prize or any portion thereof to be eligible for the Prizes; and (b) except where prohibited by law, a promotional or appearance release granting Sponsor the right to use their name and likeness for advertising and publicity purposes without additional compensation.

Entry into this Contest constitutes agreement to sign such releases. Each Contestant also must acknowledge that Sponsor has not and will not obtain or provide insurance of any kind relating to the Prizes and that each Contestant will be responsible for obtaining and paying for any property or other form of insurance relating to the Prizes. Each Contestant must also complete any additional legal documents provided by Sponsor (or third party on its behalf, if applicable) with respect to the Contest and the Prizes and return them as instructed within the timeframe specified by the Sponsor or the Contestant may forfeit the Prizes at the Sponsor's sole discretion. All decisions of the Sponsor relating to the Contest are final. The Sponsor expressly reserves the right to delay the announcement of the Finalists or bracket advancement of the Contestants for creative or technical reasons or for any other reason the Sponsor deems necessary.

14. RELEASE AND LIMITATIONS ON LIABILITY:

By participating, Entrants and Contestants agree to release and hold harmless Sponsor, Seven Bucks Productions, and YouTube, and their respective parent(s), subsidiaries, affiliates, suppliers, distributors, and each of their respective officers, directors, employees and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") from and against any claim or cause of action, including, but not limited to, personal injury, death, or damage to or loss of property, arising out of production of the Submission Materials, participation in the Contest or receipt or use or misuse of the Prizes.

The Released Parties are not responsible or liable for: (1) any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by Entrants, Contestants, typographical, printing or other errors or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest; (2) lost, interrupted or unavailable network, server, Internet Service Provider (ISP), website, or other connections, availability or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite, telephone or cable transmissions, lines, or technical failure or jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected transmissions or computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties; (3) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the entry process or the Contest;

(4) other errors or difficulties of any kind whether human, mechanical, electronic, computer, network, typographical, printing or otherwise relating to or in connection with the Contest, including, without limitation, errors or difficulties which may occur in the administration of the Contest, the processing of entries, the announcement of the Prizes or in any Contest-related materials; (5) Entrant's participation in or attempt to participate in the Contest or ability or inability to upload or download any information in connection with participating in the Contest; and/or (6) any injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from Entrant or Contestant's participation in the Contest, production of Entry Videos, or receipt or use or misuse of the Prizes. This limitation of liability is a comprehensive limitation of liability that applies to all damages of any kind, including (without limitation) compensatory, direct, indirect, or consequential damages; loss of data, income or profit; loss of damage to property; and claims of third parties.

ENTRANTS AND CONTESTANTS AGREE THAT THE RELEASED PARTIES HAVE NOT MADE NOR ARE IN ANY MANNER RESPONSIBLE OR LIABLE FOR ANY WARRANTY, REPRESENTATION, OR GUARANTEE, STATUTORY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, TITLE, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, OR NONINFRINGEMENT), IN FACT OR IN LAW, AS REGARDS TO THE ENTRY PROCESS, THE CONTEST, THE PRIZES, OR ANY COMPONENTS OF THE PRIZES IN THE CONTEST.

15. INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT:

Released Parties are not responsible for, and shall be defended, indemnified, held harmless and released by each Entrant or Contestant, and any of Entrant's or Contestant's agents, heirs, successors and assigns (the "Indemnifying Parties") against any claims, liabilities, lawsuits, judgments, causes of action, proceedings, injuries, death, losses, costs, expenses or damages of any kind resulting from, in connection with, or arising from acceptance, receipt, delivery, use, nonuse, misuse, defect in, inability to use, possession, or loss of Prizes. Furthermore, each Entrant and the Indemnifying Parties, as a condition of participating in the Contest, agrees to release, defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties, from and against any injuries, death, losses, costs, expenses, damages, claims, judgments, causes of action and any liability of any kind in connection with, resulting from or arising from this Contest, participation in the Contest, including without limitation, production of any Submission Materials, acceptance, receipt, delivery, possession, use, misuse, inability to use, defect or nonuse or loss of the Prizes that may be awarded. The Released Parties shall not be liable to any Entrant, Contestant or any other person for any part thereof, by reason of any acts of God; any action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-governmental entities (whether or not they prove to be valid); equipment failure; terrorist acts; earthquake; fire; flood; war; explosion; unusually severe weather; hurricane; embargo; labor dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal); labor or material shortage; transportation interruption of any kind; work slow-down; civil disturbance; insurrection; riot; or any other cause beyond Sponsor's sole control.

By participating in the Contest each Entrant or Contestant agrees: (i) to be bound by these Official Rules and by all applicable laws and decisions of Sponsor which shall be binding and

final; (ii) to waive any rights to claim ambiguity with respect to these Official Rules; (iii) to waive all of his/her rights to bring any claim, action, or proceeding against Released Parties, in connection with the Contest and (iv) to forever and irrevocably release, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any liability (including, but not limited to, liability for defamation, libel, slander, invasion of privacy, infringement of publicity or any intellectual property rights, any property loss, damage, personal injury, bodily injury, death, expense, accident, delay, inconvenience or irregularity, and any indirect, incidental, consequential, special, punitive or exemplary damages of any kind even if the Released Parties have been advised of the possibility of such loss or damages), costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable outside attorneys' fees) that may arise in connection with: (a) the Contest, including but not limited to any Contest -related activity or element thereof, and the Entrant or Contestant's entry, participation or inability to participate in this Contest, (b) the violation of any third-party privacy, personal, publicity or proprietary rights, (c) typographical errors in these Official Rules or any Contest materials, (d) acceptance, receipt, delivery of, possession, defects in, use, non-use, misuse or inability to use a Prize (or any component thereof), (e) any change in the prizing (or any components thereof) due to unavailability, business or creative considerations, or due to reasons beyond Sponsor's control, including but not limited to by reason of any acts of God, any action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-governmental entity (whether or not such action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) prove(s) to be invalid), equipment failure, threatened or actual terrorist acts, earthquake, war, fire, flood, explosion, unusually severe weather, hurricane, embargo, labor dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal), labor or material shortage, transportation interruption of any kind, work slow-down, civil disturbance, insurrection, riot, or any other cause beyond any of the Sponsor and others' control, or as otherwise permitted in these Official Rules, (f) any interruptions in or postponement, cancellation, or modification of this Contest, (g) human error, (h) incorrect or inaccurate transcription, receipt or transmission of any part of the entry (including, without limitation, the information or any parts thereof), (i) any technical malfunctions or unavailability of the website promotion or any telephone network, computer system, computer online system, computer timing and/or dating mechanism, computer equipment, software, or Internet service provider, or mail service utilized by any of the Sponsor and others or by an Entrant or Contestant, (j) interruption or inability to access the Contest the Contest website or any other Contest -related web pages, or any online service via the Internet due to hardware or software compatibility problems, (k) any damage to Entrant or Contestant's (or any third person's) computer and/or its contents related to or resulting from any part of this Contest (l) any lost/delayed data transmissions, omissions, interruptions, defects, and/or any other errors or malfunctions, (m) any late, lost, stolen, mutilated, misdirected, illegible, delayed, garbled, corrupted, destroyed, incomplete, undeliverable or damaged entries, (n) any wrongful, negligent, or unauthorized act or omission on the part of any of the Released Parties, (o) lost, late, stolen, damaged, delayed, or misdirected Prizes (or any element thereof), (p) the collection, use and/or sharing of Entrant or Contestant's personally identifiable information by Sponsor or its designees, or (q) the negligence or willful misconduct by each Entrant or Contestant.

16. **DISPUTES:**

Except where prohibited, Entrants and Contestants agree that: (1) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Contest that are not resolved by mutual

agreement shall be settled individually by arbitration in accordance with the then-existing American Arbitration Rules promulgated by the American Arbitration Association (AAA); (2) the arbitration shall be held in Los Angeles, CA and shall apply the substantive law of California; (3) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Contest, and in no event will Contestant be permitted to obtain attorneys' fees or other legal costs; and (3) under no circumstances will Entrants and Contestants be permitted to obtain awards for, and Entrants and Contestants hereby waives all rights to claim, indirect, punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of the Entrants, Contestants and Sponsor in connection with the Contest, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of California, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of California or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than California.

16. WINNERS' LIST/RULES REQUEST:
